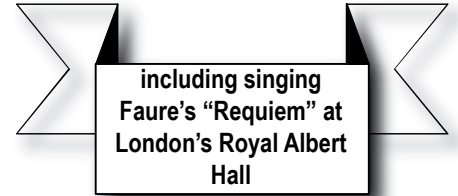

WINCHESTER
Hotel

Arrive at London airport
Clear Immigration and Customs and meet your courier
Depart by coach for Winchester (c. 1.5 hrs)
Arrive in Winchester and check in to the hotel
One-time capital of England, when London was no more than a trading centre, Winchester is now a quiet cathedral city. In the 13th-century Castle Hall, law courts still convene, and judges sit beneath a curious relic once confidently proclaimed to have been King Arthur's round table

Day 7 WORCESTER Hotel	morning	Breakfast in the hotel Depart by coach for Worcester (c. 3 hrs) stopping en route in Oxford for a guided walking tour, including entrance to Christ Church Cathedral <i>The “city of dreaming spires” holds as much of architectural and historical interest as anywhere in Britain, all packed into one square miles. The University was founded by Henry II in 1167, although the seat of learning is said to date back to 872 AD</i>
	afternoon	Lunch independent en route Arrive in Worcester and check in to the hotel <i>An old city on the River Severn, Worcester is an industrial centre noted for glove-making and porcelain. Royal Worcester China is made here, and the factory can be visited. The magnificent medieval cathedral is one of Worcester’s major architectural attractions; there are also many fine Elizabethan and Georgian houses. The city is closely associated with the music of Edward Elgar, and his birthplace, three miles west of Worcester, is now a museum</i>

	afternoon	Arrive in Bury St Edmunds and check in to the hotel <i>In the town center, a pleasant garden has been created around the ruins of the abbey built by King Canute in 1014 in honor of St Edmund, the last Saxon king of East Anglia, killed by Danish raiders in 870. Once an important wool town, Bury has two large 15th-century churches. Moyse's Hall, dating from Norman times, is now the town museum. The Theatre Royal is one of the rare Regency theatres to survive in Britain</i>
